

Kitten Care Guide

To start off: A kitten can get stressed out and may cause her not to eat for a day, so just love her. Make sure she eats by the 2nd day, and has firm stool. Kittens can get dehydrated from not eating or drinking, get loose stool and very sick. If not eating try hand feeding her to get her started, or call me. Have a blanket for her to sleep on, have fresh water and dry food out at all times and litter box near. When you're not with her, keep her in her bathroom or play pen so she doesn't get into trouble. Once you put to bed, don't let her back out if she cry's, so she learns it's bed time. Feed same time everyday, at am n pm. Minutes after eating they go potty, so watch she use's her box, you might have to place her in her box a fe times, she's in new surroundings and will need time to learn where her new litter box is. If she makes a mistake or pees where she shouldn't, **Don't Ever Hit Your Kitten**, that will just make them afraid of you and run. Use a spray water bottle. Close your bedroom doors so they don't hide under the beds, this way they will interact with you and become more social and friendly. No guarantee on temperament and behavior, **It's up to you to train them in your home.** They are litter box trained before they leave.

Cat litter is: Feline pine.

Dry food: Royal Canin baby, later you can change it to Blue Buffalo Wilderness at 6 months old., keep out all day. If you change their diet, do it very slowly each day until they are eating new diet.

Wet food: Royal Canin kitten food. Feed 2 or 3 times a day for the first month. Bengals are very sensitive to change of food, so keep them on the same diet or they will get diarrhea, loose stool and get dehydrated. So watch their stool, should be hard. No people food. Keep them on a good health program, have emergency vet numbers handy. **They will eat everything**, hair pens, pens, string, earrings, rubber bands, and bite on phone cords, keep them away from your computer cords.

You need to, spay or neuter your pet: to make you appointment by 5 mo old or and u need to send me the invoice from your licensed vet, proof of surgery by 5 months old. **If you don't spay or neuter** you will be charged \$3500 assuming kitten is a breeder.
